

4 ply acrylic - not wool

DO NOT IRON

NEEDLES:- 10 = 3¼ 12 = 2¾

V-neck Raglan in 4-ply weights

A classic design in six sizes from 2 years upwards

MATERIALS

4 [5, 6, 7, 8, 9] oz. PATONS BEEHIVE 4-ply, Patonised, or PATONS NYLOX 4-ply, Patonised, or

5 [6, 7, 8, 9, 10] oz. PATONS PURPLE HEATHER 4-ply.

Two No. 12 and two No. 10 BEEHIVE needles or QUEEN BEE if stainless rigid needles preferred. Set of four No. 12 QUEEN BEE needles with points at both ends, measured by BEEHIVE gauge.

You must use the Patons brands recommended above to be sure of a successful result.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit 22 [24, 26, 28, 30, 32] inch chest. Length at centre back, 14½ [15½, 16½, 17½, 18½, 19½] ins. Sleeve seam, 9 [10½, 12½, 13½, 15, 16½] ins.

These instructions apply to the above measurements only; adaptations to sizes other than those given in this booklet are not available.

TENSION

7 sts. and 9 rows to one square inch on No. 10 needles, measured over stocking stitch. See page 2 for how to check your Tension, and Abbreviations.

FRONT

Using No. 12 needles, cast on → 78 86 94 102 110 118
sts. Work in K.1, P.1 rib for → 2 2 2½ 2½ 3 3
ins.

Change to No. 10 needles and proceed in stocking
stitch until work measures → 9½ 9½ 10½ 10½ 11½ 11½
ins. from beg., finishing at end of a P. row.

Commence raglan armholes by casting off → 2 3 4 5 6 7
sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Continue to shape armholes and divide for V neck
as follows:—

1st row—K.1, K.2 tog.t.b.l., K. → 34 37 40 43 46 49
sts., turn.

2nd row—P.

3rd row—K.1, K.2 tog.t.b.l., K. to last 2 sts.,
K.2 tog.

Continue dec. at armhole edge on every alt. row
at the same time dec. at neck edge on every 3rd row
until 3 dec. (4 in all) have been worked at neck edge.
Still dec. 1 st. on every alt. row at armhole edge,
continue dec. 1 st. at neck edge on every 4th row
from previous dec. until 6 sts. remain.

Continue without further dec. at neck edge but still
dec. 1 st. at armhole edge on every alt. row until all
sts. are worked off.

Rejoin wool to remaining group of → 37 40 43 46 49 52
sts. and work to match First Half, noting that
K.2 tog.t.b.l. is worked K.2 tog. throughout.

Change to No. 10 needles and proceed in stocking						
stitch until work measures	9½	9½	10½	10½	11½	11½
ins. from beg., finishing at end of a P. row.						
Commence raglan armholes by casting off	2	3	4	5	6	7
sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.						
Continue to shape armholes and divide for V neck						
as follows:—						
1st row—K.1, K.2 tog.t.b.l., K.	34	37	40	43	46	49
sts., turn.						
2nd row—P.						
3rd row—K.1, K.2 tog.t.b.l., K. to last 2 sts.,						
K.2 tog.						
Continue dec. at armhole edge on every alt. row						
at the same time dec. at neck edge on every 3rd row						
until 3 dec. (4 in all) have been worked at neck edge.						
Still dec. 1 st. on every alt. row at armhole edge,						
continue dec. 1 st. at neck edge on every 4th row						
from previous dec. until 6 sts. remain.						
Continue without further dec. at neck edge but still						
dec. 1 st. at armhole edge on every alt. row until all						
sts. are worked off.						
Rejoin wool to remaining group of	37	40	43	46	49	52
sts. and work to match First Half, noting that						
K.2 tog.t.b.l. is worked K.2 tog. throughout.						

BACK

	22"	24"	26"	28"	30"	32"
Work as Front to armhole shaping, finishing at end of a P. row.						
Shape raglan armholes as follows:—						
1st and 2nd rows—Cast off—→ sts., work to end.	2	3	4	5	6	7
3rd row—K.1, K.2 tog.t.b.l., K. to last 3 sts., K.2 tog., K.1.						
4th row—P.						
Rep. 3rd and 4th rows until—→ sts. remain.	24	26	28	30	32	34
Cast off.						

SLEEVES

Using No. 12 needles, cast on—→ sts.	42	44	46	48	50	52
Work in K.1, P.1 rib for 2½ ins.						
Next row—Rib—→	4	5	6	4	5	6
sts., (inc. in next st., rib—→	6	6	6	7	7	7
sts.) 5 times, inc. in next st., rib to end—→ sts.	48	50	52	54	56	58
Change to No. 10 needles and proceed in stocking stitch, inc. 1 st. at both ends of 5th and every following—→	8th	8th	8th	6th	6th	6th
row until there are—→ sts.	60	66	72	78	84	90
Continue on these sts. until work measures—→ ins. from beg.	9	10½	12½	13½	15	16½
Shape raglan top as follows:—						
Cast off—→	2	3	4	5	6	7
sts. at beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. at both ends of next and every alt. row until 6 sts. remain. Cast off.						

TO MAKE UP AND NECKBAND

Omitting ribbing, with wrong side of work facing, block each piece by pinning out round edges.						
Omitting ribbing, press each piece using a warm iron and damp cloth.						
Using a flat seam for ribbing and a fine back-stitch seam for remainder, join side and sleeve seams, and stitch Sleeves into position.						
Using set of No. 12 needles, with right side of work facing knit up—→	114	122	130	138	146	154
sts. round neck, including 1 st. through loop at centre V and sts. from top of sleeves.						
Work—→	6	6	8	8	10	10
rounds in K.1, P.1 rib, dec. 1 st. at each side of st. knitted up at centre V on every round.						
Work—→	6	6	8	8	10	10
rounds in K.1, P.1 rib, inc. 1 st. at each side of st. knitted up at centre V on every round.						
Cast off loosely in rib.						
Fold Neckband at centre and flat-stitch cast-off edge to knitted-up edge on wrong side of work.						
Press seams.						

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NECK BAND CAN BE KNITTED ON
2 NEEDLES IF SIDE SEAMS AND LEFT
SLEEVE RAGLAN IS NOT JOINED TILL
KNITTING IS FINISHED,
