

# CLEMENTIN HAT & SCARF

SKILL LEVEL **Beginner**

## MEASUREMENTS

Hat: One size Scarf: 15cm/6in wide by 130cm/51in long.

## MATERIALS

Hat:

- One 50g ball of MillaMia Naturally Soft Merino in Fuchsia (143) (M).
- Two balls in Daisy Yellow (141) (C).
- Pair each of 3mm (US 2) and 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

Scarf:

- Two 50g balls in each of MillaMia Naturally Soft Merino in Fuchsia (143) (M) and Daisy (141) (C) Please Note: Striped Scarf uses 4 balls M and 1 ball C.
- Pair of 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

## TENSION / GAUGE

25 sts and 34 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

cont continue; k or K knit; k2 tog knit two stitches together; p or P purl; p2 tog purl two stitches together; rem remain (ing); st(s) stitch(es); st st stocking stitch

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## PLAIN HAT

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and M, cast on 110 sts.

1st row P2, [k3, p3] to end.

2nd row K3, [p3, k3] to last 5 sts, p3, k2.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Work a further 16 rows.

\*\* Mark each end of last row with a coloured thread.

Change to 3mm (US 2) needles.

Work a further 17 rows in rib.

Cut off M.

Join on C.

Change to 3.25mm (US 3) needles.

Starting with a k row cont in st st until hat measures 15cm/6in from coloured thread, ending with a p row.

## Shape top

Row 1 [K10, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 2 P to end.

Row 3 [K9, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 4 P to end.

Row 5 [K8, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 6 P to end.

Row 7 [K7, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 8 P to end.

Row 9 [K6, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 10 P to end.

Row 11 [K5, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 12 P to end.

Row 13 [K4, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 14 P to end.

Row 15 [K3, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 16 P to end.

Row 17 [K2, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 18 P to end.

Row 19 [K1, k2 tog] 9 times, k2.

Row 20 P to end.

Next row [K2 tog] 10 times.

Next row [P2 tog] 5 times.

Leaving a long end, cut off yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up and secure.

Join seam, reversing seam for brim.

## POM-POM HAT

Work as Plain Hat to end.

Use left over yarn in M to make a pom-pom and attach to top of Hat.

## HAT WITH STRIPES

With 3.25mm (US 3) needles and M, cast on 110 sts.

1st row P2, [k3, p3] to end.

2nd row K3, [p3, k3] to last 5 sts, p3, k2.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Work a further 4 rows M, [2 rows C, 4 rows M] twice.

Work as Plain Hat from \*\* to end.
